All donations will be collected at 5 pm on December 6 and taken to the Department of Social Services distribution site. The gifts should not be wrapped and should be placed in the box designated "White Gift," which will be located either just inside the door to the old Narthex or directly outside the door. - school age child BOY/GIRL (5-10)
- pre-teen BOY/GIRL (10-12)
- gift card for a TEEN (13-17) or SENIOR (60+)
